TUESDAY:

READ: 1 Corinthians 13

Today's passage is a familiar reminder as we focus on brotherly affection this week. Paul taught that love ought to be elevated in every aspect of our lives and the foundation for all that we do. Answer the questions below:

- Q: Do you often view love as an action or an emotion? Explain.
- Q: Which characteristic of love (from verses 4-7) do you find most challenging to embody? Why?
- Q: What tends to get in the way of love often, according to verse 5?
- Q: How do you typically respond when you face disappointments in relationships?
- Q: Why is Paul confident that love is greater than faith and hope (v. 13)?

WEDNESDAY

READ: Romans 13:8-14

The Christian life is characterized by love - both in relationship with others and in our pursuit of holiness. We are called to live distinctly by remembering that salvation is nearer than we first believed. Answer the questions below:

- Q: Rewrite verse 8-10 in your own words to explain what Paul is saying.
- Q: What does it look like to live out your faith with a sense of urgency?
- Q: How does living according to Christ's character change the way we view the specific sins listed in verses 13-14?
- Q: How can you balance a heart that loves others with a life striving for righteousness?

THURSDAY

READ: Psalm 22:22-27

Brotherly love extends beyond individual relationships and into a global, capital "c," Church worship of God. The diversity and unity of the Church ought to marvel a lost world. Answer the questions below:

- Q: Rewrite this section of the Psalm in your own words.
- Q: How can you contribute to a greater spirit of unity in your community?
- Q: What is your greatest obstacle when it comes to unity?
- Q: Where is there division in your relationships that you need to surrender to the Lord?

FRIDAY

READ: James 2:14-17

Spiritual growth that happens at camp is meant to propel you into greater obedience as you return home. Write down three specific things the Lord taught you this week and how you plan to apply those truths to your life. Spend time intentionally praying over each action item.
