

SUPER SUMMER CORE VALUES COMES FROM 2 PETER 1:3-11



“3 By his divine power, God has given us everything we need for living a godly life. We have received all of this by coming to know him, the one who called us to himself by means of his marvelous glory and excellence. 4 And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world’s corruption caused by human desires.

*5 In view of all this, make every effort to respond to God’s promises. Supplement your faith with a generous provision of **moral excellence**, and moral excellence with **knowledge**, 6 and knowledge with **self-control**, and self-control with **patient endurance**, and patient endurance with **godliness**, 7 and godliness with **brotherly affection**, and brotherly affection with **love for everyone**.*

8 The more you grow like this, the more productive and useful you will be in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. 9 But those who fail to develop in this way are shortsighted or blind, forgetting that they have been cleansed from their old sins.

10 So, dear brothers and sisters, work hard to prove that you really are among those God has called and chosen. Do these things, and you will never fall away. 11 Then God will give you a grand entrance into the eternal Kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.”

Super Summer began in 1986 at Oklahoma Baptist University, as a training opportunity for youth ministers to bring Christian young people who were interested in advancing their personal spiritual growth. Now Super Summer has over 3,000 participants and promises to continue to grow as the need for student leaders intensifies. Super Summer Oklahoma is an independent camp operated by a board of directors made up of youth ministers, pastors, and lay leaders.

CORE BELIEFS

JESUS IS GOD AND SAVIOR

Jesus is both fully God and fully human. He is Christ, the Son of God. Born of a virgin, He lived a sinless life and performed many miracles. He died on the cross to provide people forgiveness of their sin and eternal salvation. Jesus rose from the dead, ascended to the right hand of the Heavenly Father, and will return in power and glory at an appointed time known only by the Heavenly Father. *Romans 5:8, 2 Corinthians 5:21, Hebrews 1:3*

THE HOLY SPIRIT IS GOD AND EMPOWERER

The Holy Spirit is supernatural and sovereign. The Holy Spirit indwells in every believer at the moment of salvation, and then empowers believers to be a bold witness and to serve God effectively as they yield to His leading. The Holy Spirit is the believer’s guide and counselor. He convicts individuals of sin, uses God’s word to mature believers into Christlikeness, and secure them until Christ’s return. *John 16:8-10, Acts 1:8*

THE BIBLE IS GOD’S WORD

The Bible is God’s written revelation to people, given through human authors, divinely inspired by the Holy Spirit. The Bible is infallible, totally sufficient, complete, and authoritative for matters of life by faith. *2 Timothy 3:16*

THE CHURCH IS GOD’S PLAN

The Holy Spirit immediately places all people who put their faith in Christ into one spiritual body, the church, of which Christ is head. The primary expression of the church on earth is in autonomous and local congregation of baptized believers. The purpose of the church is to glorify God by taking the gospel to the entire world. The church exists for: Evangelism, Discipleship, Ministry, Missions, and Fellowship. *Acts 2:41-42*

SALVATION IS BY FAITH ALONE

All human beings are born with a sin nature, separated from God, and in need of a Savior. Salvation comes only through a faith relationship with God through Jesus Christ. A person must come to faith in Christ by repenting of his/her sin. Once this occurs, a person can receive Christ’s forgiveness and also receive eternal life. Salvation is instantaneous and is accomplished solely by the Holy Spirit. This salvation is wholly of God by grace and is given on the basis of the shed blood of Jesus Christ and not a result of any human work or effort. All the redeemed are secured in Christ forever. *John 10:27-30, Ephesians 2:8-10*

TEAM ROLES

DEANS

Deans (D) are responsible for humbly leading their team in all preparations prior to and during the week of Super Summer. This requires planning meetings with the team to assign teaching, pick a theme and plan how to execute it, assign materials needed, and begin establishing a positive working relationship with each executive staff member. Deans are responsible for financial tracking and budgeting, as well as the overall safety and welfare of their entire school.

ASSISTANT DEANS

Assistant Deans (AD) work closely with the Dean and support them as they share needed responsibilities. Like the Dean, their role is to serve the executive staff, TLs, and students while helping lead the school to excellence through planning, preparation, implementation, and teaching.

TEAM LEADER COORDINATOR

Team Leader Coordinators (TLC) is the shepherd to the Team Leaders during the week of camp. This role requires encouraging, serving, and preparing the TLs. They will pair leaders for all groups, model small group discussion, and have an awareness of how each "family" is doing.

SCHOOL COORDINATOR

School Coordinators (SC) are a support for all other roles within the staff. They fill in the gaps for teaching, serving TL's, and assisting with school responsibilities.

DREAM TEAM MEMBERS


Dream Team Members (DT) are another support role where the focus isn't primarily the school but the camp overall. Each DT member is connected to the school and also connected with the office staff by attending daily meetings there.

TEAM LEADERS

Team Leaders (TL) are the backbone of camp. Team leaders will follow the instruction of their executive staff and will report directly to the Team Leader Coordinator. TL's spend the most time with students guiding and facilitating spiritual conversations around the topics discussed at camp.

ORANGE SCHOOL students will learn how to implement practices of **SELF-CONTROL** and temptation resistance.




YELLOW SCHOOL students will learn how to develop **PATIENCE** through **ENDURANCE** as God sends trials and tests.




GREEN SCHOOL students will learn how to strengthen their pursuits towards **GODLINESS** and avoid pride's pitfalls.



BREAKOUTS 2026

CALLED TO MINISTRY

Though all believers are called to ministry in our life and conversations with others, some are called to a life of serving the Church in vocational ministry. Lead by our Camp Pastor, if you are trying to discern and seek counsel from Scripture and whether or not you are called to ministry, this is a great breakout for you.

CONVERSATIONAL EVANGELISM

Rather than seeing non-believers as “projects” that we share the Gospel with, we as believers are called to engage with others in open and honest conversations about God and what He has done as we present the Good News of Jesus Christ. Rather than a formula to follow to have these conversations, our goal is to give you tools to better your conversations centered around Jesus.

CHRISTIAN ETHICS: HOW SHOULD I RESPOND TO ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE?

Christian ethics asks not only what we can do, but what we should do. As artificial intelligence becomes more present in our everyday lives, followers of Jesus must learn how to think biblically and faithfully about its use and impact. In this breakout, students will explore what Scripture teaches about humanity, wisdom, creativity, and responsibility in light of advancing technology.

GRASPING GOD’S WORD

Studying the Bible is more than reading words on a page—it is learning to listen to God through His Word. This breakout is designed for students who want to begin studying Scripture seriously, perhaps for the very first time. Together, we will explore simple and effective tools that help us understand what the Bible says, what it means, and how it applies to our lives today. Students will practice observing, interpreting, and applying Scripture in ways that build confidence and clarity. This session invites students to grasp God’s Word so it can shape their faith, obedience, and everyday living.

PRAYING SCRIPTURE

Prayer is not just speaking to God—it is responding to what He has already spoken. In this breakout, students will learn how to pray using Scripture as their guide and foundation. Together, we will explore how God’s Word shapes our prayers, aligns our hearts with His will, and deepens our intimacy with Him. Students will practice turning biblical passages into personal and meaningful prayers. This session invites students to develop a prayer life rooted in Scripture rather than circumstance.

COMMUNICATING GOD’S WORD

Do you want to start a Bible study? Maybe you’ve been asked to lead a devotion for FCA? But sometimes it is hard to know how to get started. This breakout is for any student who want to take what they have studied and learned from God’s Word and communicate it to others. We plan to give you basic principles to grasp and put into practice for your studying and preparing for teaching Scripture.

MISSIONS

Missions is not simply a program of the church—it is the heart of God for the nations. In this breakout, students will hear from men and women who have served as overseas missionaries and have witnessed God at work among the nations. Together, we will explore what Scripture teaches about God’s global mission and the role every believer plays in it. Students will be challenged to think prayerfully about calling, obedience, and what it means to take the Gospel to the ends of the earth. This session invites students to consider whether God may be leading them toward international missions and how to take faithful next steps.

THE WHY OF WORSHIP

Worship is more than music or art. Worship is our expression back to a King who is worthy of our praise. If you are interested in how to lead your church or youth group in drawing attention to Jesus.

MENTAL HEALTH

God cares deeply about every part of who we are—including our mental and emotional health. In this breakout, students will hear from Christian mental health professionals who will help connect biblical truth with real struggles many students face today. Together, we will address the growing epidemic of loneliness and explore God’s design for connection, community, and care. Students will learn healthy, faithful ways to process emotions, seek help, and support others without shame or fear. This session invites students to experience the hope of being fully known by God and reminded that they were never meant to walk alone.
